



## Article 7.-

## Communication and documentation necessary to publish the posting

The transport company must communicate the driver's journey by road before the start of the journey. To do this, you must use a standard multilingual public interface form connected to the *Internal Market Information System (IMI)*, which must include the following information:

- Identification of the transport company, indicating the community license number.
- Contact details of the transport manager or contact person in the state of establishment (where the company has its headquarters) who serves as a liaison with the authorities of the country where the driver has traveled and for the sending and receiving of documents or notifications.
- Identity, address and driving license number of the driver.
- Start date of the driver's employment contract and legislation applicable to it.
- Planned start and end dates of the trip.
- Motor vehicle registration plates.
- Type of transport service provided: goods, passengers, international or cabotage.

This information will be stored in the IMI for 24 months.

In addition to this electronic communication prior to the trip, the transport company must provide the driver with a paper or electronic copy of this travel communication; Therefore, the driver, in the case of a roadside check, must have the following documents, on a mandatory basis:

- Copy of the displacement declaration presented by the transport company for which you work at the IMI.
- eCMR electronic consignment note ).
- The mandatory tachograph records and, in particular, the manual records of the border crossing you have had to carry out.
